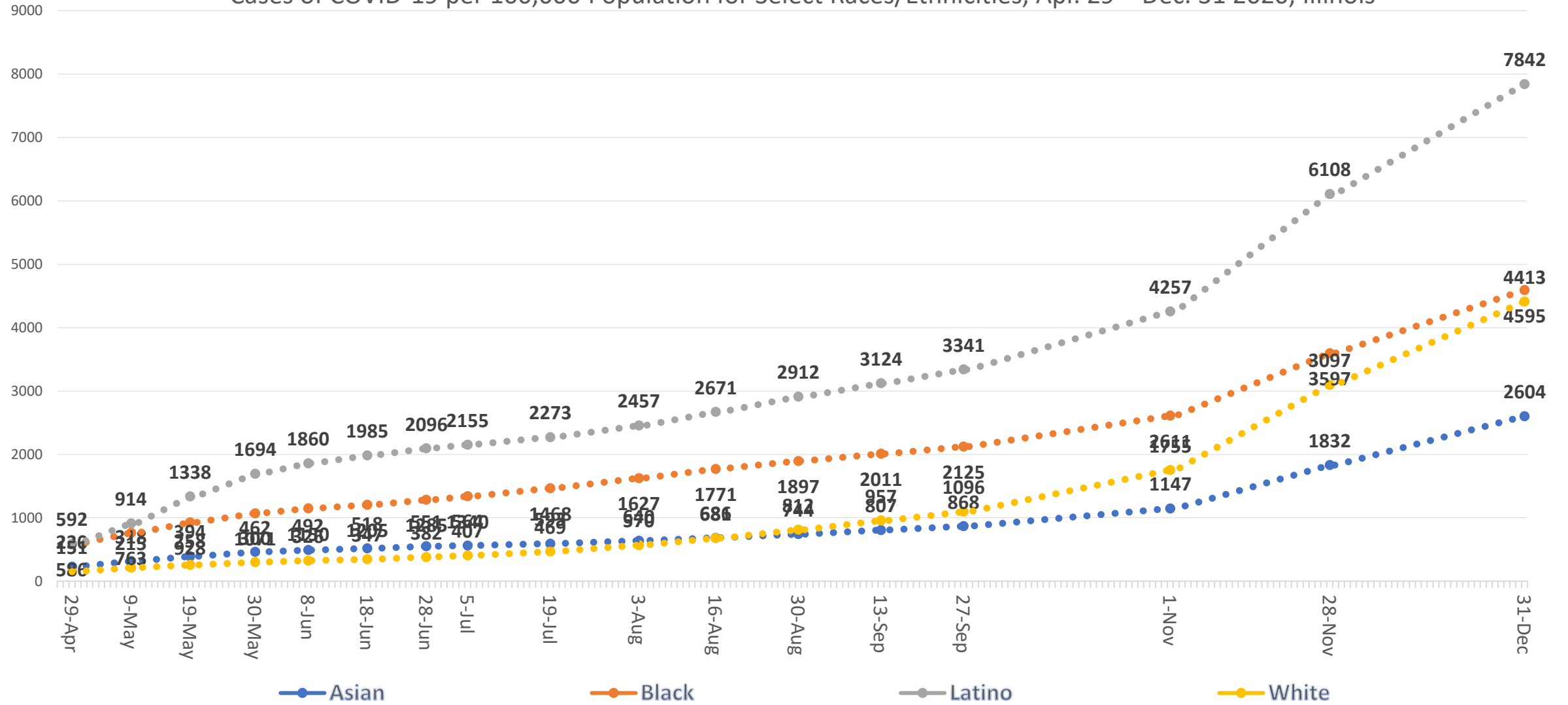
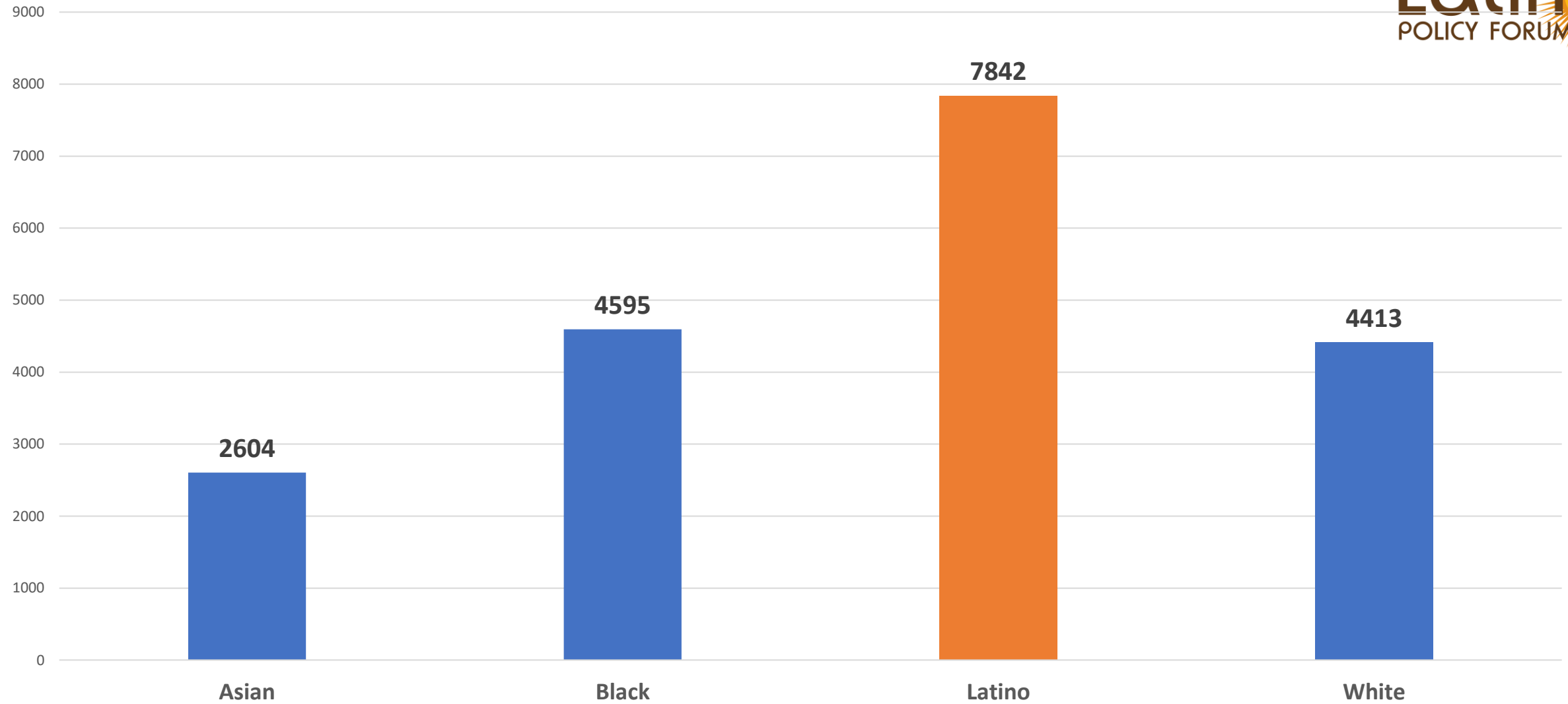

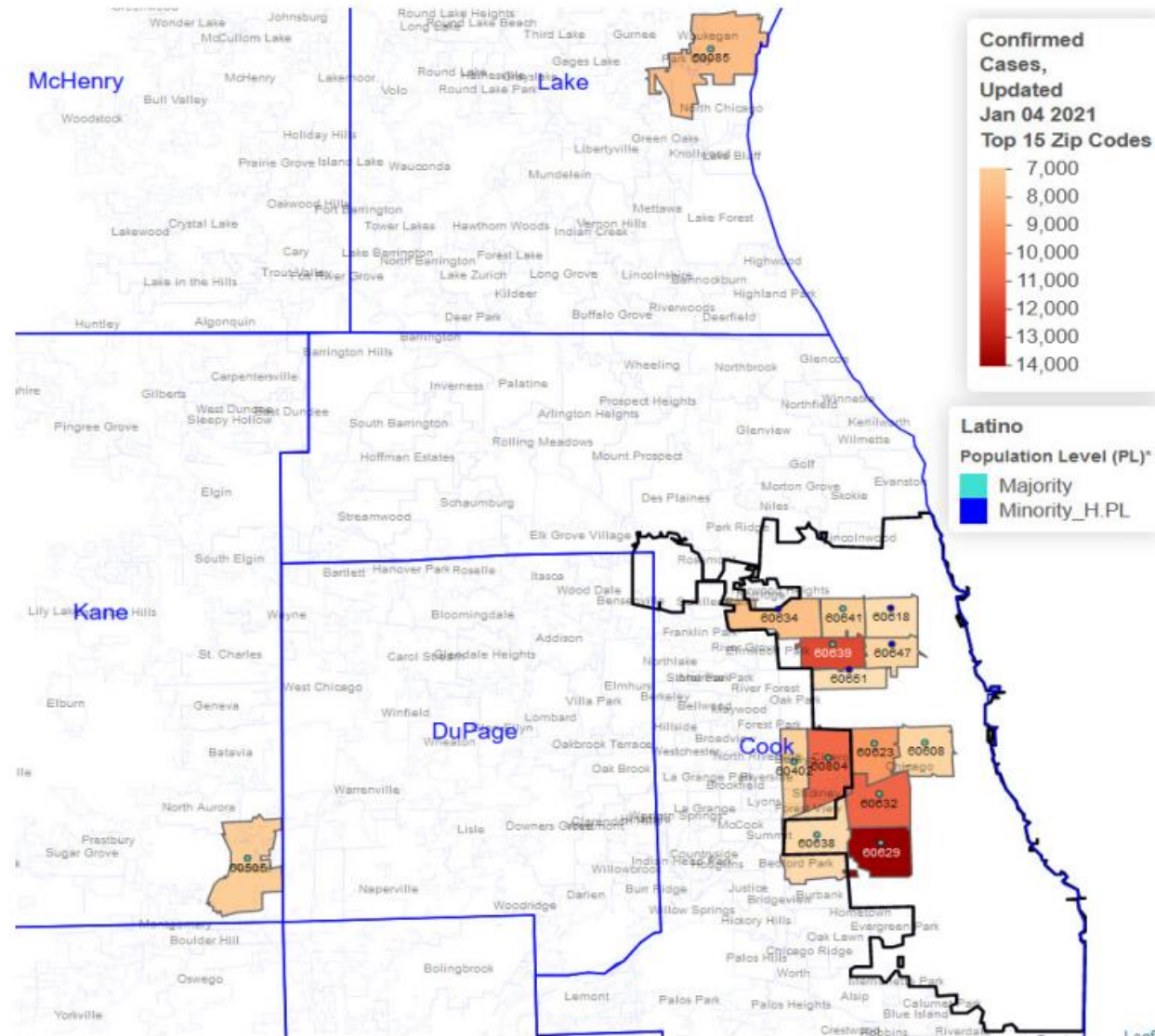

In these situations, the information regarding deaths here published for those zip codes must be considered incomplete.

<sup>2</sup> Derived via quantiles in Chicago's Covid-19 incidence data. The rate level classifications for zip codes are relative and subject to change as new cases are added.
